



We're "Taking Cornhole to the Players" of Ohio with the Ohio Cornhole Tour. While this tour will focus mainly on Northeast Ohio, we are certainly open to expanding beyond that if the players will have us.

The Ohio Cornhole Tour will feature BLIND DRAW tournaments where each player that enters will be randomly partnered with another player at the tournament. Players will be playing for cash at each qualifying event while they attempt to qualify for the **Ohio Cornhole Tour Championships**.

Along with that, at each qualifying event we will be bringing the **Ohio Cornhole Tour Money Shot**. Each player will have the option to buy raffle tickets to see if their name is pulled to take the Money Shot for the night. The person with the winning raffle ticket will get to pitch four bags and see how many they can make. The more they make, the more money they will take home!



The Ohio Cornhole Tour Championships:

The Ohio Cornhole Tour Championships will wrap up the 2012 tour and will only be open to those players that have qualified. We will not be allowing anyone to buy directly into the event. Just like the qualifying events, the Championships will be one big blind draw tournament. Everyone that has qualified and attends the event plays for FREE and will be randomly partnered with another player that has qualified and attends the event. The exact prize amounts for this event will be determined based on the number of qualifiers that take place.

The Ohio Cornhole Tour Money Shot:

The Ohio Cornhole Tour Money Shot will be held at all qualifying events which have at least 7 teams competing. The exact amount of the Money Shot will vary from event to event. Recently a similar pot in Missouri reached over \$2,000. While that is not common, it's not impossible to get that high. In our case we will give out a portion of the pot based on the number of bags made. The lucky person selected to take the Money Shot will get 4 bags to see how many he/she can make. Without any warm-ups, if the player makes all 4 bags, they win the entire pot. If they make 3 out of 4 bags they win 40% of the pot. 2 out of 4 gets them 10% of the pot and 1 out of 4 gets them 5% of the pot. All remaining money is then put back into the Money Shot Prize Pot and taken to the next qualifying event.



Why Host An Event?

That's an easy one, first off it's FREE! No cost to the host location to run a qualifying event. Plus we bring all of the necessary equipment for the event! Along with that, it gives patrons or club members something fun to do and the host establishment can make plenty of money on food and drink sales.
