Doubleheader Blind Draw Qualifying Event! 3 Games Guaranteed in Both Tournaments!

The Creekside Golf Dome is welcoming the Ohio Cornhole Tour back for another doubleheader qualifying event! We will again be playing two qualifying tournaments on the same day at the same location. Players will have the option to compete in one OR two blind draw tournaments with the winners of each tournament qualifying for the Ohio Cornhole Tour Championships!

Cornhole Tournament Information:

Time

- Doors open at 1pm with registration closing for the first tournament at 2pm. The second tournament will begin immediately following the conclusion of the first tournament.

*Note - Both tournaments are blind draw tournaments, so should we have an odd number of players enter the tournament, the last person entered will be refunded their entry fee and not allowed to play as we must have an even number.

Blind Draw

- Each player that enters either tournament will be randomly paired with another player that enters. The format will be double elimination, single games, three games guaranteed.
- Any teams losing their first two games will be put into a Consolation bracket with the winner winning \$5 in food/drink credit that has to be used at the Golf Dome

Entry Fee

- The entry fee will be \$10/person to enter each tournament



Prizes

- Top teams will share in 70% of the entry fees (with an additional 10% going into the Championship Prize pot) Exact payouts are based on number of teams entered and can be seen here <http://ohiocornholetour.com/qualifiers/prize-structure/>

- Winning team will also qualify for the Ohio Cornhole Tour Championships

*Note – winning team qualifies if at least 7 teams enter the tournament. If 16 or more teams enter then the top 2 teams will qualify.



The Ohio Cornhole Tour Money Shot:

As long as at least 7 teams enter, we will hold the Ohio Cornhole Tour money shot during the first tournament. Players will have the option of buying raffle tickets to see who gets to step up and pitch four bags. Whomever has the winning ticket will attempt to make all four bags (with no warm-ups) to win the pot! Make all four bags and you win the entire pot! Make three and you get 25%, make two and you get 10% and make just one and you get 5%. Exact amount of the money pot is based on how many tickets are sold and what the pot was prior to the event.
