Ohio Cornhole Tour Qualifying Event!

Come enter a blind draw cornhole tournament for just \$10/player on Thursday March 15th in Stow!
The winning team will qualify for the Ohio Cornhole Tour Championships!

Cornhole Tournament Information:

Time

- Cornhole registration opens at 6pm and the tournament begins around 7pm.

Blind Draw

- Each player that enters the tournament will be randomly paired with another player that enters. The format will be double elimination, single games.
Note – This is a blind draw tournament, so should we have an odd number of players enter the tournament, the last person entered will be refunded their entry fee and not allowed to play as we must have an even number.

Entry Fee

- The entry fee will be \$10/person



Prizes

- Top teams will share in 70% of the entry fees (with an additional 10% going into the Championship Prize pot)

- Winning team will also qualify for the Ohio Cornhole Tour Championships
*Note – winning team qualifies if at least 7 teams enter the tournament. If 16 or more teams enter then the top 2 teams will qualify.



The Ohio Cornhole Tour Money Shot:

As long as at least 7 teams enter, we will hold the Ohio Cornhole Tour money shot during the tournament. Players will have the option of buying raffle tickets to see who gets to step up and pitch four bags. Whomever has the winning ticket will attempt to make all four bags (with no warm-ups) to win the pot! Make all four bags and you win the entire pot! Make three and you get 25%, make two and you get 10% and make just one and you get 5%. Exact amount of the money pot is based on how many tickets are sold and what the pot was prior to the event.
